I hope that this newsletter finds you and your families healthy and safe.

While we are still operating on a scaled-back level due to the Public Health restrictions, our volunteers are still reaching out to those in need to lend them the helping hand that they need.

Our Welcome Table Program will be continuing in its takeout format and is serving about 130 meals every Wednesday night at Trinity Anglican Church. Our visitors are missing the social engagement that our regular meal program provided when we were indoors, hopefully, we will be able

to get back to this soon. We are doing this with only 57 active volunteers, spread over four teams, when we were serving indoors we had over 110 active volunteers.

Martha's Table is also in "takeout mode" and is back from a well-deserved summer off, serving over 50 meals every Thursday morning at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church. 30% of these meals are being delivered to our visitors by our volunteers! A big thank you to Anne Newman and her team of 9 for doing the work of 20 throughout the Pandemic!

Bridging the Gap has been operating on an appointment-only basis for over a year now, which has allowed us to provide a safe atmosphere for our visitors and our volunteers, and still be able to offer the supports that are needed to our community. We are currently helping about 70 families a month with grocery and essential supports. Thanks to our amazing volunteers for continuing to help those in need in our community!
