

Oscar Peterson

 Oscar Peterson was a Canadian jazz pianist, composer and educator who is considered one of the greatest jazz pianists of all time. He was born in Montreal, Quebec, on August 15, 1925. ... He began playing trumpet and piano at age 5. He focused solely on piano at age 8 following a year-long battle with tuberculosis. Oscar's first instructor was his sister, Daisy.
