- Aluminum Pop Tabs

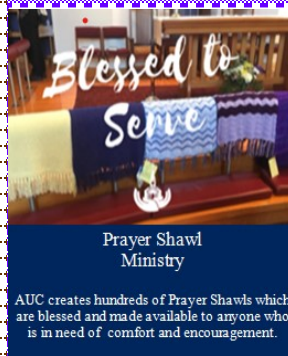
