erations and budget”

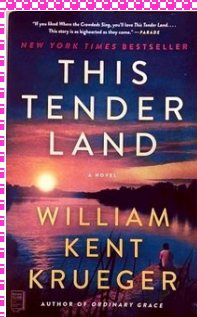
EDGE looks forward to sharing more exciting

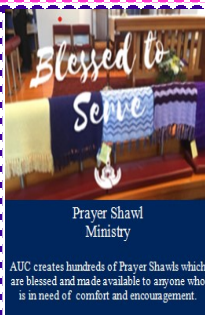

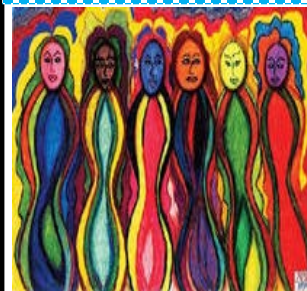
