

<u> United Church of Canada – 100 Years</u>

Timeline Leading up to Church Union

1875 – Presbyterian Church in Canada is formed from four branches of Presbyterianism

1884 - Methodist Church is formed from four branches of the Methodist Church

1885 – Synod of the Anglican Province of Canada invites Methodists and Presbyterians to discuss union.

1889 - Conference on Church Unity meets in Toronto

1904 – Joint committee on Church Union meets for the first time.

 $1906-\mbox{Anglicans}$ and Baptists decline to join negotiations. Joint Committee on Church Union agrees on Basis of Union.

- 1912 Majority of Presbyterian presbyteries and congregations vote in favour of union.
- 1914 The United Church of Canada is approved as the name.
- 1924 The United Church of Canada act is passed by the Dominion Parliament; congregations are given the right to decide by majority vote, not to join the union.

1925 – Inaugural service on $10^{\rm th}$ of June creates a church of approximately 8,000 congregations and 600,000 members.

1925 – Non-concurring Presbyterians continue as the Presbyterian Church in Canada with approximately 1,000 congregations and 150,000 members.




Funday Sunday— Children's Program


