The United Church of Canada was born today. Its advent attended by high revelry of rejoicing hearts. Not in temple or cathedral nor among long drawn aisle and fretted vault echoing the note of praise but as if symbolic of the new born church to hallow and to beautify, to make the place of its sect glorious, the holy festivities were held within an area set apart to athletic prowess and physical endeavor.

Great and impressive was the scene. Seven thousand reverent souls were there, they too but

representatives of the great host which no man could number, from ocean unto ocean, who have lived to see this day and seeing, have rejoiced.

It is an hour for national pride and hope. In the highest things of life Canada has led the world. Precedent for this there is none.

# Impressive Hallowing of United Church – Communion Partaken by all Present BIG STEP FORWARD

#### Signing of Parchment, Few Spoken Words, Bring New Church into Existence

All ages and ranks of life were represented in the throng from vigorous youth to decrepit nonagenarianism. The halt, the lame and the blind were among those represented.

A crashing chorus "The Church's One Foundation" brought the mighty assemblage to its feet as the 350 commissioners to the first general council filed through the doorway and assumed the seats reserved for them. Three hundred and forty-nine men and <u>one woman Mrs. Louis C. McKinney of Edmonton</u>, the first of her sex to sit in the parliament of the new church as she was one of the first to sit in the legislature of her native province Alberta.

## **Returning of the Symbols of Ministry Service**


## Date: Sunday June 22, 2025 Time: 11:00 am Worship Service
