The Women's Missionary Society

The union of the Methodist and Congregational Churches and part of the Presbyterian Church in 1925 to form the United Church of Canada brought a wider vision and a deeper sense of fellowship. Membership increased from 90 to 115. At the initial meeting of the combined auxiliaries on July 8th 1925, Mrs. Conn gave a report of the former Presbyterian missionary work, Miss Jane Greaves read a paper on the work of the former Congregational Church and Mrs. C.J. Blewett outlined that of the former Methodist Church.

In March 1926 the new executive was elected representative of both former Presbyterians and Methodists. The union of the three churches proved to be a very happy and harmonious one.
