Source: A Church with the Soul of a Nation by Phyllis D. Airhart The vast majority of (Presbyterian) ministers & overseas missionaries chose to join the United Church leaving the United Church with a surplus (and the Presbyterians with a shortage) of personnel.

1925 – Inaugural service on 10th of June creates a church of approximately 8,000 congregations and 600,000 members.

1925 – Non-concurring Presbyterians continue as the Presbyterian Church in Canada with approximately 1,000 congregations and 150,000 members.

Churches before union: Congregationalists - 171, Methodists - 4,797, Presbyterians -4,515. After union: United - 8,688, Presbyterian - 784
